

Camas County Commissioners Meeting
February 25, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Kramer. Also present were Commissioner Ralph, Deputy Clerk Katherine Rablin, and Prosecuting Attorney Matt Pember. Commissioner Colter couldn't attend due to snow conditions.

The Board reviewed the Agenda. It was discovered that the county didn't meet the statute for publication of Chapter 10 Conditional Use Permits from Jan 22, 2019. Commissioner Ralph made a motion to amend the agenda for redeliberation. Seconded by Commissioner Kramer. Motion passed.

The Board began deliberations on Chapter 10, Conditional Use Permits. Commissioner Ralph moves to accept Chapter 10 as recommended, seconded by Commissioner Kramer. Motion Passed.

10:45 am Terry Lee attends to discuss the Memorandum of Understanding with the Camas Creek Cooperative Weed Management. Matt Pember will review the contract.

10:50 am Virgil Tinker is in attendance to discuss the road maintenance in West Magic. Virgil reviews prior road maintenance and snow removal. He updated the Board on a proposed joint Highway District between the two counties for spring and winter road maintenance. He will keep the board updated on meeting the requirements of establishing a highway district.

11:45 am Motion is made by Commissioner Ralph to approve a school request for \$2950.00 that addresses Bullying Prevention. Seconded by Commissioner Kramer. Motion Passed

11:55 am Commissioner Ralph updated the Board on the courthouse ADA requirements, the Board will come up with a plan to satisfy these requirements.
