

FIRST DAY OF THE REGULAR SESSION OF THE

March 11, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Kramer. Also present were Commissioner Ralph, Commissioner Colter, Prosecuting Attorney Matt Pember, Clerk Korri Blodgett and two members of the public.

The Board reviewed the Agenda. Commissioner Ralph made a motion to approve the Agenda as posted. Seconded by Commissioner Colter. Unanimous.

The Board discussed the legal requirements of a synopsis on legal publications.

Commissioner Ralph updated the Board on the Region IV Development that he attended recently. They are discussing doing an assessment on cities to contribute to the program as they benefit as well as the counties.
