Chamber of Commerce Vice President Jerry Young met with the Board to request support for the 2019 fourth of July fireworks display. The Board has committed to \$ 250 but will look into an increase. Commissioner Colter made a motion to approve the support. Seconded by Commissioner Ralph. Unanimous.

The Board discussed Road and Bridge implement purchases. They would like to have Ted come in to discuss further.

The Board continued to work on an updated personnel policy.

The Board recessed at 12:10 p.m.
