PUBLIC NOTICE

This is to inform the general public that the building permit fees have been raised effective January 1, 2020.

A building permit is required for any owner or authorized agent who intends to construct, enlarge, alter, repair, move, demolish or change the occupancy of a building or structure, or to erect, install, enlarge, alter, repair, remove convert or replace any electrical, gas, mechanical or plumbing system, the installation of which is regulated by the building code, or cause any such work to be done shall make application to the building official and obtain the required permit.

Any person commencing work requiring a permit on a building, structure, electrical, gas mechanical or plumbing system before obtaining the necessary permits shall be subject to double the permit fee in addition to the required permit fee.

Agricultural permits will be issued for structures that meet the definition as defined in the International Building Code.

"Tiny homes" shall meet the requirement of the International Residential Code and the State of Idaho, Division of Building Safety requirements.

Structures submitted for permit must contain a site plan, foot & foundation plan, floor plan, building section, wall section, roof plan & reschek per the permit guidelines. Plan for residential buildings may be drawn by a draftsman and are not required to be stamped by an architect.
