

ORDINANCE NO. 176

AN ORDINANCE OF CAMAS COUNTY, IDAHO, ADOPTING ORDINANCE 176 PROVIDING FOR A RESTRICTION ON TANDEM TRAILERS FROM BIG SMOKY TO SKUNK CREEK OVER FLECK SUMMIT; PROVIDING A DEFINITION OF TANDEM TRAILERS; PROVIDING STANDARDS PROVIDING FOR ENFORCEMENT; PROVIDING FOR A SUMMARY OF THIS ORDINANCE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CAMAS COUNTY, IDAHO:

A. Restrictions: It shall be unlawful for any vehicle to progress beyond the signs at or near Big Smoky or Skunk Creek pulling tandem trailers as defined below.

B. Definitions:

1. Trailer: shall be defined as set forth in Idaho Code §49-121
2. Tandem Trailer: Any vehicle pulling two or more trailers, one behind the other.

C. Sheriff authorization:


1. The Sheriff, or any law enforcement officer with jurisdiction, is hereby authorized to cite and compel compliance to any vehicle in violation of this Section.


D. Enforcement; Fines:

1. If any vehicle is found to be in violation of the provisions of this Section, and the identity of the operator cannot be determined, the owner, person, corporation or named lessee in whose name said vehicle is registered, shall be held prima facie responsible for said violation.
2. A violation of the provisions hereof is punishable by a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) to be paid by the owner, person, corporation, or named lessee in whose name the vehicle is registered. (Ord. 176 May 11, 2020, date passed)
