The successful applicant must have the required skills to identify, collect, release, and monitor all available Bio agents that currently have been released and those new agents that have been approved for future release. The applicant must be able to work closely with our current partners which include, Government agencies, Private landowners, State agencies, and the Camas Creek Cooperative Weed Management Area. The applicant will also be required to provide their own transportation, do their own payroll, and provide workers compensation insurance, as well as have their own crew to perform the required tasks. Applicant will also be required to seek other funding avenues through grants and/or agreements with prospective agencies. The successful applicant will be required to provide a detailed budget and year end reports of expenditures and work performed along with GIS mapping of all bio agent releases within the boundaries of the Camas Creek Cooperative Weed Management Area.
