

Camas County Commissioners Meeting  
January 28, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Kramer. Also present were Commissioner Ralph, Commissioner Colter, Prosecuting Attorney Matt Pember, and Clerk Korri Blodgett.

The Board reviewed the Agenda. Commissioner Ralph made a motion to approve the agenda as posted. Seconded by Commissioner Colter. Unanimous.

The Board reviewed the meeting minutes of January 22. Commissioner Colter made a motion to approve the minutes with the corrections noted. Seconded by Commissioner Ralph. Unanimous.

Commissioner Kramer made a motion to go into Executive Session pursuant to Idaho Code 74-206(1)(a)&(b) to consider personnel matters. A roll call vote showed all in favor. The Board entered into Executive session at 9:35 a.m. The Board came out of Executive session at 10:10 a.m.

The Board discussed the Road and Bridge supervisors' position that will be available starting April 1, 2019. Camas County will be accepting applications until February 22, 2019 and a full detailed job description is available at the Clerk's office.

South Central Public Health District County Representative Pam Jones met with the Board and provided a presentation on some of the programs available. Parents as Teachers Program, which serves families with at-risk children, Vaping among High School Students, and Operation Red File, are some of the beneficial programs available.
