

Camas County Commissioners Meeting
June 17, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 pm by Commissioner Kramer. Also present were Commissioner Ralph, Commissioner Colter, Prosecuting Attorney Matt Pember, Clerk Korri Blodgett, and an individual from the public.

The Board reviewed the Agenda. Commissioner Ralph made a motion to approve the Agenda as posted. Seconded by Commissioner Colter. Unanimous.

The Board discussed interview questions for the probation officer position.

Trial Court Administrator Shelli Tubbs, District Court Administrator Eric Wildman and Magistrate Judge Dolan met to review the 2020 District Court budget proposal.

Southern Idaho Executive Director Melissa Berry met with the Board and provided an update on their efforts to develop and promote tourism and recreation in Southern Idaho.

The Board discussed opening and closing of graves by the Road and Bridge Department. Commissioner Ralph made a motion to authorize Ted to perform the opening and closing of the grave for the upcoming service and instruct the cemetery board to continue with their advertising efforts to find a individual/business to provide the service. Seconded by Commissioner Colter. Unanimous.

The Board continued reviewing probation questions.

The Board reviewed a request from the Camas County Rodeo to waive fees for the event on July 12th and 13th. It was a consensus of the Board to charge the two hundred dollars per event(3) and to offer a reduction in price if there are any volunteers to offset the fee that the county pays out for services.

The Board interviewed Diane McFerran for the position of Probation Officer.

Road and Bridge Supervisor met with the Board to discuss equipment lease/purchases and Asphalt options.
