

LEGAL NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING & DELIBERATION
Rezone

Pursuant to Idaho Code 67-6509 & 67-6511, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Camas County Board of Commissioners will hold a **public hearing and deliberation in the American Legion Hall at 114 E. Camas Ave., Fairfield, ID 83327 on the 8th day of February, 2021 at 1:00 PM** or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard.

The purpose of this hearing is for the public as well as the Board of Commissioners to hear a request from Ix-nay Investment Trust to rezone approximately 300 acres of land from Ag-5 to Ag-80. **The Camas County Planning and Zoning Commission held a public hearing on the 22nd of September, 2020 and has recommended approval of the rezone.** These parcels of land are located approximately 10 miles East and 1.5 miles North of the intersection of U. S. 20 and Soldier Rd., Fairfield, ID 83327, and are more particularly described as follows:

A parcel of land being following, all of which is within T.1S., R.16E., Boise Meridian, Camas County, Idaho
The Southwest Quarter of Section 5 (160 Acres +/-)
The East Half of the Northwest Quarter of Section 8 (80 Acres +/-)
The East Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 8, excepting there from the southerly portion currently zoned R-4, SE1/4SW1/4, approximately 20 Acres. (60 Acres +/-)

Public comment will be limited to 5 minutes at the public hearing.
