

## Camas Commissioner Meeting Minutes February 18, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 9:02 a.m. by Commissioner Kramer. Also present were Commissioner Colter, Commissioner Ralph, Prosecuting Attorney Jim Thomas, County Clerk Brianna Walter and two members of the public.

The Board reviewed the agenda. Commissioner Colter made a motion to approve the February 18<sup>th</sup> 2025 meeting agenda as posted, seconded by Commissioner Ralph, approved.

The Board reviewed the February 10<sup>th</sup> 2025 meeting minutes. Commissioner Colter made a motion to approve the minutes as corrected, seconded by Commissioner Ralph, approved.

The Board reviewed the February 10<sup>th</sup> 2025 brief synopsis. Commissioner Ralph made a motion to approve the brief synopsis as corrected, seconded by Commissioner Colter, approved.

Commissioners reviewed the map for the EMS agreement with Camas and Blaine County. Questions will be discussed further in the meeting with Bass Sears, current representative for the agreement.

Commissioners discussed the County Fee Schedule.

9:30 a.m. Planning & Zoning Board Member interview with Greg Johnson. Motion by Commissioner Colter to appoint Mr. Johnson to the Planning & Zoning Board effective immediately. Seconded by Commissioner Ralph, all in favor, approved.

Commissioners reviewed the County Vehicle Policy and Drug Testing Policy for the County. Clerk contacted Idaho Counties Risk Management Program to see if they have a policy to review.

Josh Ashmead, Road & Bridge Supervisor, attended to discuss Soldier Road and Wells Summit Parking. Motion by Commissioner Colter to table the discussion, second by Commissioner Ralph. Item tabled.

Commissioners discussed ideas to help Road & Bridge with the Commercial Drivers License (CDL) requirement. Commissioner Ralph has contacted the Idaho Launch Program to see if there are scholarships available for the CDL program.

Jen Fredrickson, County Treasurer, attended the meeting to review the County Treasurer Reports for January 2025.

Travis Martin, County Sheriff, attended to discuss the Idaho Office of Emergency Management Grant for Chairman signature. The grant is up to \$4,600 for a reimbursement that can be used for a new copier that is needed at the sheriff's office. Motion by Commissioner Colter to sign the grant application, seconded by Commissioner Ralph, motion passed.

Meeting broke for lunch at 11:55 a.m.

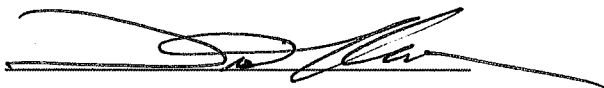
Meeting resumed at 1:15 p.m.

John Pine, Camas Ambulance Representative, reviewed questions / concerns with the draft version of the agreement and maps. Travis Martin, Camas Sheriff, mentioned concerns for radio communication between the agencies. Revisions will be made and discussed at a later date. Motion by Commissioner Colter to postpone signing until Mr. Sears and Mr. Pine are able to work together and update the agreement. Seconded by Commissioner Ralph, item postponed.

Commissioners reviewed Resolution 227 that would replace Resolution 224 regarding county holiday pay. Motion by Commissioner Colter to approve Resolution 227, second by Commissioner Ralph, approved.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 3:05 p.m.
