



Camas Commissioner Meeting Minutes

October 27th, 2025

The meeting was called to order at 9:07 a.m. by Commissioner Kramer. Also present were commissioner Colter, Commissioner Ralph, Prosecuting Attorney Jim Thomas, and County Clerk Deanna Lenker.

Sheriff Travis Martin requested an invoice for M2 be paid before any further late charges were assessed. M2 upgraded the camera system for the sheriffs office. Sheriff Martin explained that this is still under a grant. However with the federal government shutdown the claim can not be paid before further late charges will be accrued. Commissioner Colter moved to pay the claim to M2 now with the understanding that Camas County will still be reimbursed. Commissioner Ralph seconded the motion. Approved

Deanna Lenker, County Clerk, presented the quarterly financial report to the Board.
