



Camas Commissioner Meeting Minutes January 20, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 9:01 a.m. by Commissioner Kramer. Also present were Commissioner Colter, Commissioner Ralph, Prosecuting Attorney Jim Thomas, and County Clerk Deanna Lenker.

The Board reviewed the agenda. Commissioner Ralph made a motion to approve the January 20, 2026 meeting agenda as posted, seconded by Commissioner Colter, approved.

The Board reviewed the January 12, 2026 meeting minutes. Commissioner Ralph made a motion to approve the minutes as corrected, seconded by Commissioner Colter, Approved.

The Board reviewed the January 12, 2026 brief synopsis. Commissioner Ralph made a motion to approve the brief synopsis as corrected. Commissioner Colter seconded the motion. Approved.

Commissioner Colter moved to have all county employees use the new time card format for a three month trial. January through March 2026. Commissioner Ralph seconded the motion. Approved
