

Camas Commissioner Meeting Minutes April 20, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 9:01 a.m. by Chairman Kramer. Also present were Commissioner Colter, Commissioner Ralph, Jim Thomas, Prosecutor, and County Clerk Deanna Lenker.

The Board reviewed the agenda. Commissioner Ralph made a motion to approve the April 20, 2026, meeting agenda as posted, seconded by Commissioner Colter. Approved.

The Board reviewed the April 13, 2026, meeting minutes. Commissioner Colter made a motion to approve the minutes as corrected, seconded by Commissioner Ralph. Approved.

The Board reviewed the brief synopsis dated April 13, 2026. Commissioner Colter moved to approve the brief synopsis as corrected. Commissioner Ralph seconded the motion. Approved.

The Board reviewed information for pending Tax deed sale. The Board would like the discussion to continue on April 27th 2026.

Commissioner Ralph moved to adopt Resolution 237 destruction of county records as listed on the spreadsheet. Commissioner Colter seconded the motion. Approved

The Board of Commissioners will still submit a drought request for Camas County even though a 2026 Order declaring drought emergency was signed on April 13th 2026 by Governor Little and Director Weaver of Idaho Department of water resources, State of Idaho.

No action needed for Clerk's quarterly financial report.


