

Camas Commissioner Meeting Minutes May 18, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 9:05 a.m. by Chairman Kramer. Also present were Commissioner Colter, Commissioner Ralph, Jim Thomas, Prosecutor, and County Clerk Deanna Lenker.

The Board reviewed the agenda. Commissioner Colter made a motion to approve the May 18, 2026, meeting agenda as posted, seconded by Commissioner Ralph. Approved.

The Board reviewed the May 11, 2026, meeting minutes. Commissioner Colter made a motion to approve the minutes as corrected, seconded by Commissioner Ralph. Approved.

The Board reviewed the brief synopsis dated May 11, 2026. Commissioner Ralph moved to approve the brief synopsis as corrected. Commissioner Colter seconded the motion. Approved.

Commissioner Colter moved to sign the representation letter for Zwygart John & Associates for the fiscal year 2025 audit. Commissioner Ralph seconded the motion. Approved

Chairman Kramer presented a 28-day draft employee time sheet for law enforcement to the Board. Chairman Kramer will get the draft timesheet over to Sheriff Martin for review.

Leo Cavanaugh, Planning & Zoning Administrator, joined the meeting to discuss the option of Planning and Zoning to review the County's Area of City Impact (ACI), ACI Subdivision ordinance, and ACI Comprehensive plan with specific verbiage. Commissioner Ralph moved to have the Planning & Zoning board review for special zoning for the current ACI, Subdivision, and Comprehensive plan. Commissioner Colter seconded the motion. Passed.

Discussion on Camas County's current catering permit regulations, and whether the an ordinance needs to be written. The Board would like to have a time set aside for public comments before an ordinance is drafted.
