



## Camas Commissioner Meeting Minutes June 15th, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 9:08 a.m. by Commissioner Kramer. Also present were Commissioner Colter, Commissioner Ralph, Prosecuting Attorney Jim Thomas, and County Clerk Deanna Lenker.

The Board reviewed the agenda. Commissioner Colter motioned to approve the June 8th, 2026 meeting agenda as posted, seconded by Commissioner Ralph, approved.

The Board reviewed the June 15th, 2026 meeting minutes. Commissioner Ralph motioned to approve the minutes as corrected, seconded by Chairman Kramer, approved.

The Board reviewed the June 15th, 2026 brief synopsis. Commissioner Ralph made a motion to approve the synopsis, seconded by Chairman Kramer, approved.

Discussion on the per-day use rate at the Camas County Airport for the United States Forest Service (USFS) and Bureau of Land Management (BLM).

Josh Bovey, Captain, Camas Fire Department, presented a request for the SRS Title III funds. Josh provided a detailed list of equipment/supplies that are needed to repair the wildland fire truck and bring it up to code for responding to calls. Josh explained that the fire department is currently using 2 rigs that are outdated and fail to run when needed.

Sheriff Travis Martin requested SRS Title III funds to either purchase a UTV or 4-wheeler to respond to calls in the mountains where patrol vehicles can not get to. Sheriff Martin did request at the end of the meeting that the fire departments request was greater than his department's at this time.

Commissioner Colter moved to go into Executive Session for Idaho Code 74-206(f) as needed for pending or threatened litigation. Seconded by Commissioner Ralph, roll call vote in favor, motion passed. The executive session started at 11:01 a.m. Executive session ended at 12:28 p.m. Capital Project Funds grant update.


Commissioner Colter moved to designate Chairman Kramer to sign the Idaho Office of Emergency Management (IOEM) grant application. Commissioner Ralph seconded the motion.

Jordan Zwygart presented the final fiscal year 2025 Camas County Audit. Jordan went over his findings. Commissioners requested the Clerk to send the audit to elected officials and department heads for review. Motion by Commissioner Colter to postpone, Seconded by Commissioner Ralph. Approved.

The Board reviewed Resolution Number 238, request for 6-month extension on the Capital Project Finds grant. Commissioner Ralph moved to approve Resolution number 238 request for 6-month extension on the Capitl Project finds grant. Commissioner Colter seconded the motion.
