

Camas Commissioner Meeting Minutes July 13th, 2026

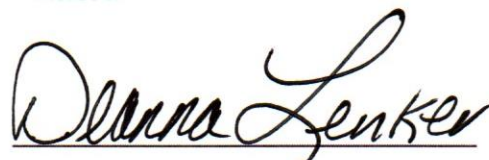
