



Camas Commissioner Meeting Minutes June 22, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 9:01 a.m. by Commissioner Kramer. Also present were Commissioner Colter, Commissioner Ralph, Prosecuting Attorney Jim Thomas, and County Clerk Deanna Lenker.

The Board reviewed the agenda. Commissioner Colter motioned to approve the June 22nd, 2026 meeting agenda as posted, seconded by Commissioner Ralph, approved.

The Board reviewed the June 15th, 2026 meeting minutes. Commissioner Ralph moved to approve the minutes as corrected; seconded by Chairman Kramer; approved.

The Board reviewed the June 15th, 2026 brief synopsis. Commissioner Colter moved to approve the synopsis, seconded by Commissioner Ralph; approved.

Commissioner Colter moved to change the Tax Deed Sale from July 27th, 2026 to August 17th, 2026 @11:00 a.m., with publication dates of July 29th, 2026 and August 5th, 2026 in the Courier News. Commissioner Ralph seconded the motion. approved.

Deanna Lenker, Clerk, presented the letter from the Friends of Fairfield and the City of Fairfield Resolution 2026-6, requesting funds for the Kids Pond cleanup and repairs. The Board requested that the Friends of Fairfield present their request in person.

The publication notice for the Fairfield Fire Department's Secure Rural School funding request for \$64,253.83 needs to be published for 45 days. Put on the agenda July 13th at 9:00 a.m.

Commissioner Colter expressed interest in adding a 10- to 15-minute public comment period to the agenda for community members.

Matt Filbert of the U.S. Forest Service, Matt Guanady, Ed Rablin & Chad Meyer joined the meeting to provide an update on the current fire season. Fleck road widening project will start July 6th 2026. Timber sales in Fern Creek and North Fleck areas are starting up.

Danyon Fontenot, Building Inspector, presented the Planning & Zoning budget for fiscal year 2027.

Sheriff Martin joined the meeting to present the Sheriff's Office budget for fiscal year 2027.

Carol Regan and Cindy Kinder from the Extension Office joined the meeting to present the Extension Office budget for fiscal year 2027.

Marshall Ralph, National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians, presented the Ambulance budget for fiscal year 2027.

Terry Lee Weeds, Supervisor, presented the Weeds Department budget for fiscal year 2027.

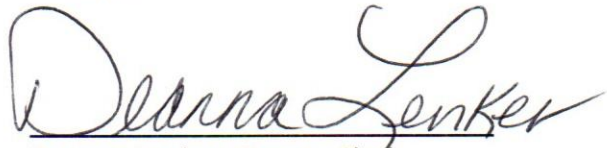
