### MARRIAGE LICENSE REQUIREMENTS

#### **You will need:**

1. To appear together at a County Recorder's Office.
2. Fee of \$28 (\$15 for license & \$13 for recording).
3. **A social security number for each applicant.** (Idaho Code 32-403)
  - Both applicants will need their Social Security cards.
  - If an applicant has a letter stating that a Social Security number is being issued, you will need to wait until you can provide that information.
  - Non-U.S. residents should bring identification from the country in which they are citizens.
4. **One of the following as proof of identity and age:**
  - Current driver's license
  - State-issued identification card
  - **US Passport or a valid foreign passport with a current Visa stamp**
  - Original birth certificate or certified copy

#### **You should know:**

- You do not need to be a resident of Idaho to obtain an Idaho marriage license; an Idaho State marriage license is only valid for ceremonies performed within the State of Idaho.
- There is no waiting period before using the license; you may get married the same day.

#### **After one year:**

There is no expiration date on the license. If not used within a year, contact the Idaho Bureau of Vital Records and Health Statistics at 208-334-5988.

#### **Under 18:**

16 and 17-year-old applicants must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian, or have a notarized statement signed by their parent or guardian. (Legal guardians will need to show a certified copy of their appointment of guardianship.)

#### **Under 16:**

If the applicant is under 16 years of age, they will need parental consent in the form of a notarized statement and parent(s)/guardian(s) must be present. **Permission must be obtained from the Court.**

**NOTE:** Blood tests are not required. There is no waiting period.
