



Camas Commissioner Special Meeting Minutes July 27th, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 9:05 a.m. by Commissioner Kramer. Also present were Commissioner Colter, Commissioner Ralph, Prosecuting Attorney Jim Thomas, and County Clerk Deanna Lenker.

The Board reviewed the agenda. Commissioner Ralph moved to approve the July 27th, 2026 meeting agenda as posted, seconded by Commissioner Colter. Approved.

The Board reviewed the July 20th, 2026 meeting minutes. Commissioner Colter moved to approve the minutes as corrected, seconded by Commissioner Ralph. Approved.

The Board reviewed the July 20th, 2026 brief synopsis. Commissioner Colter moved to approve the synopsis, seconded by Commissioner Ralph. Approved.

No Community input.

No public comment regarding Secure Rural Schools funds.

Jacob Johnson Owner & CTO, Scott Barrett Owner & CEO, Scott Linsley COO & Chad Larsen Head of Construction with ETS, met with the Board regarding broadband project work order changes. Change Order for the Miller Tower reducing the tower from 60 feet to 35 feet or under, all materials for the 60-foot tower had already been purchased. ETS stated that it expects to be able to sell the used 60-foot tower; however, the sale could take up to 36 months. ETS proposed that Camas County and ETS split the cost of \$16,995.00, with each party paying \$8,497.50. ETS will reimburse the County's share after the 60-foot tower is sold.

Commissioner Colter moved to approve the unified work order change for all 3 towers, ETS to proceed to secure the Miller tower site for safety reasons, Commissioner Ralph seconded the motion. Motion approved

Commissioner Ralph moved to approve the cost-sharing agreement for the 60-foot tower. Commissioner Colter seconded the motion. Motion approved.

Trial Court Administrator Sadie Fisher and Magistrate Judge Ash presented the Fiscal Year 2027 District Court budget.

Deanna Lenker, County Clerk began the Fiscal Year 2027 budget review for Clerk's office, Justice Other, Prosecutor, and Other funds.

Sheriff Martin continued the Fiscal Year 2027 budget discussion.

Sheriff Martin presented the Board with a draft ordinance establishing a temporary ban on open fires in Camas County.

Commissioner Colter moved to enter Executive Session pursuant to Idaho Code §74-206(b) for personnel matters at 11:49 a.m. Commissioner Ralph Seconded the motion . A roll call vote was taken, and all Commissioners voted in favor. The Board exited Executive session at 12:30 p.m.

Commissioner Colter moved to approve Resolution No. 239 Authorizing the Destruction of County Records. Commissioner Ralph seconded the motion. Motion approved.

No Action needed on setting appeal hearing date.

No action needed on Resolution No. 240.

No action needed on Ordinance No. 13.

The Commissioners reviewed the Notice of Tax Deed Property Sale publication which was scheduled to be published in the Courier Newspaper on July 29th and August 5th 2026.

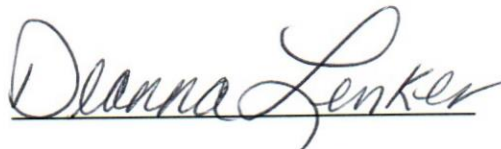
