

Camas Commissioner Meeting Minutes August 24th, 2026

Chairman Kramer called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m. Also present were Commissioner Colter, Commissioner Ralph, Prosecutor Jim Thomas and County Clerk Deanna Lenker.

The Board reviewed the agenda. Commissioner Ralph moved to approve the August 24th, 2026 meeting agenda as posted; the motion was seconded by Commissioner Colter. Approved.

The Board reviewed the August 17th, 2026 meeting minutes. Commissioner Colter moved to approve the minutes as corrected, seconded by Commissioner Ralph. Approved.

The Board reviewed the August 17th, 2026 brief synopsis. Commissioner Colter moved to approve the synopsis, seconded by Commissioner Ralph. Approved.

Commissioner Colter moved to approve the SRS title III funds to Camas County Fire Department for \$28,000.00. Commissioner Ralph seconded the motion.

Treasurer Jen Frederickson presented the July financials.

Josh Ashmead, Road and Bridge Supervisor joined the meeting for further discussion on Sheep Lane and snow plowing. Commissioner Colter moved to leave the status of Sheep Lane with no change. Commissioner Ralph seconded the motion. Approved.

Chairman Kramer opened the public hearing at 10:32 a.m. Ordinance number 187, repealing Camas Counties Ordinance number 13. Public hearing closed 10:33 a.m. with no public comment. The board began deliberations on Ordinance number 187. Commissioner Colter moved to approve Ordinance number 187 repealing Ordinance number 13. Commissioner Ralph seconded the motion. Approved.

Chairman Kramer opened the public hearing at 10:38 a.m. Chairman Kramer read Resolution number 240, rescinding Resolution number 23. With no public comment, the public hearing closed at 10:40 a.m. The board began deliberations. Commissioner Colter moved to adopt Resolution number 240, rescinding Resolution number 23. Commissioner Ralph seconded the motion. Approved.

Jason Bergsma, Balanced Rock Insurance, Jason reported that we need to have the insurance set up and ready before the last payroll in September, Jason asked the Clerk to have the last payroll report for the new insurance report.

Chairman Colter moved to enter Executive Session pursuant to Idaho Code §74-206(f) for pending/threatened litigation at 1:03 p.m. Commissioner Ralph seconded the motion. The

Board took a roll call vote, and all Commissioners voted in favor. The Board exited Executive Session at 2:05 p.m.

Chairman Colter moved to enter Executive Session pursuant to Idaho Code §74-206(b) for personnel matters at 2:05 p.m. Commissioner Ralph seconded the motion. The Board took a roll call vote, and all Commissioners voted in favor. The Board exited Executive Session at 2:36 p.m.

Commissioner Colter moved to postpone the Heath reimbursement arrangement decision until the September 14th, 2026 meeting for further decision. Chairman Kramer seconded the motion.

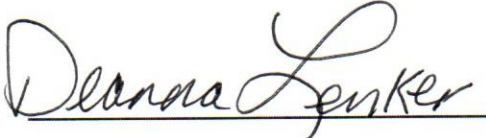
The Board discussed the Fiscal Year 2027 budget.
